

Dr. Richard Webb is Professor and Dean of the College of Arts and Humanities at Southern University and Organist/Music Associate at First United Methodist Church in Baton Rouge. He previously served as Dean of the College and Chief Academic Officer at Westminster Choir College in Princeton, New Jersey and Chair of the Departments of Music at San Francisco State University and East Tennessee State University. He holds the Doctor of Philosophy degree in musicology with a minor in art history from the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music, as well as Master of Fine Arts and Bachelor of Fine Arts degrees in organ performance from Ohio University, which accorded him a Distinguished Alumnus Award for Achievement in Music. Characterized in recent reviews as “a musician foremost” and “an artist of clear aesthetic vision served by elegant technical mastery,” Dr. Webb has concertized extensively as both soloist and collaborative performer. He is a member of the Louisiana Artists Roster and a Louisiana Division of the Arts Fellow.
